// HOW TO GET TO FIBES

FIBES is located in the eastern part of the city, just 5 kms away from the San Pablo Airport and the main train station of de Santa Justa. Access by car is easy by taking the SE-30 ring road and it is also well connected by public transport.


ACCESS FROM THE AIRPORT

The San Pablo Airport is only 5kms from the Congress Centre.

It takes less than 10 minutes by car.

ACCESS BY TRAIN

Every 35 minutes, from Santa Justa Station, Virgen del Rocío Hospital and San Bernardo Multi modal Station. It takes less than 15 minutes.







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ACCESS BY BUS

4 lines from the city centre B4 - 27 - 22 - BTR to Fibes in less than 30 minutes Every 10-15 minutes

Bus Fares:

Single ticket: €1.40 (one zone)

Bus Card : Price: € 1.50 Minimum Charge : € 7

Single trip without transfer: € 0.69 Single trip with transfer: € 0.76

Tourist Card 1 day : € 5

Tourist Card 3 days: 10€ (It allows to use all the buses lines

the whole day around)



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Taxi Fares: Taxi fares in Seville are really competitive as distances are really short. An approximate rate from the centre to FIBES should be between 12/15 euros according to the traffic.

By BIKE

Seville is a middle easily manageable City. Using a bike to get around in Seville is a great choice, as the city is very flat and we enjoy mild temperatures throughout the year. Currently, there are 200 kms bike lanes in the city since Sevilla signed up the Aalborg Commitments at the occasion of the 5th European Sustainable Cities and Towns Conference held in FIBES in 2007.

Seville is nowadays the best city for cycling in Spain, second in Europe, fourth in the world (according to agency reuters) and also according Copenhagenize.com the prestigious blog specialized in Bicycle Urbanism for Modern Cities.

In Seville, as in many cities in Europe there is the possibility of picking up a bike and dropping it off in a different point of the city. This service is called Sevici: http://www.sevici.es/

The city has 2.500 rental bikes of service and spread over 250 Parking Areas.

- Prices: Short-term pass, 10,00€; Long-term pass, 25,00€
- First 30 minutes:. Short-term pass, free; Long-term pass, free.
- 1st hour (after the initial 30 free minutes): Long-term pass, 0,50 €; Short-term pass: 1,00€
- 2nd and each subsequent hour (after the initial 30 free minutes): Long-term pass; 1,00€; Short-term pass, 2,00€
